

**ORDINANCE NO. 645**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING § 265-39 TO INCLUDE A PORTION OF DERSTINE ROAD NOT TO BE USED FOR PARKING AT ANY TIME**

**WHEREAS**, the Township has identified a portion of Derstine Road that becomes congested or creates an unsafe traffic condition when used for parking,

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and desire of the Township Commissioners through this Ordinance to place restrictions on the use of said portion of Derstine Road for parking,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

**SECTION I.** Section 265-39 of the Code of Hatfield Township is hereby amended to add the following:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	
Derstine Road	Both	1769 feet from the apex of the curb radius on the north side of Cowpath Road and 233 feet to the apex of the curb radius on the south side of the intersection at Cowpath Road

**SECTION II.** All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

**SECTION III.** The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Hatfield Township Code.

**SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.
