

ORDINANCE NO. 647

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING § 265-10
“MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN STREETS”
RELATIVE TO THE SPEED LIMIT ON BETHLEHEM PIKE**

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (“PennDOT”) conducted an engineering and traffic study and has changed the speed limit for a portion of Bethlehem Pike in Hatfield Township,

WHEREAS, the Township Code must be amended to coincide with the determination and Speed Limit Permit issued by PennDOT on September 10, 2013,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

SECTION I. The following is deleted from Section 265-10.A:

Name of Street	Between	Maximum Speed Limit (miles per hour)
Bethlehem Pike [Added 9-23-2009 by Ord. No. 588]	Township Line Road and a Point 240 feet south of Bergey Road	55
Bethlehem Pike [Amended 9-23-2009 by Ord. No. 588]	A point 240 feet south of Bergey Road and Unionville Pike	45

SECTION II. Section 265-10.A. is hereby amended to add the following:

Name of Street	Between	Maximum Speed Limit (miles per hour)
Bethlehem Pike (S.R. 4085)	Orvilla Road and the Route 309 Expressway	50

SECTION III. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Hatfield Township Code.

SECTION IV. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Hatfield Township Code.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.
