

ORDINANCE NO. 649

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 202
“PEDDLING AND SOLICITING”**

WHEREAS, the Township of Hatfield provides definitions, rules and regulations regarding peddling and soliciting in the Township;

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Commissioners desires to amend the length of time a license to peddle or solicit is effective as well as the hours during which a solicitor or peddler may engage in soliciting or peddling.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 202-4 “License Fee” is amended so that the first sentence is deleted and the following provided in its place:

“Licenses shall be issued under this Chapter for an initial period of one (1) month for an amount to be established by Resolution from time to time by the Board of Commissioners, which shall be paid to the Township Police Department and shall be for the use of the Township.”

Section 202-7 “Hours of Operation” is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

“Any person licensed as a solicitor or peddler under this Chapter may engage in soliciting or peddling on any day of the week between 9:00 AM and 7:00 PM.”

SECTION II. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Hatfield Township Code.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.
