

**ORDINANCE NO. 655**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD,  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 265  
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Hatfield prescribes rules and regulations relative to vehicles and traffic in the Township;

**WHEREAS**, the Township Board of Commissioners desires to amend the code to permit parking on certain streets during a snow and/or ice emergency due to the fact that inadequate off-street parking is available.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

**SECTION I.**

Section 265- 45 “Parking and other conduct prohibited during snow and/or ice emergency” is amended such that Paragraph A is deleted and replaced with the following:

“A. Whenever the Township declares a snow and/or ice emergency, no owner or occupier of any premises or his or her guest or business invitee shall park any vehicle on any street or highway of the Township except the following:

Wendy Way;  
North Ford Drive;  
Truman Drive;  
Grant Avenue;  
South Ford Drive;  
Washington Lane;  
Adams Drive;  
Roxbury Road;  
Needham Circle;  
Stoneham Circle;  
Hertford Drive – from Elroy Road to Towamencin Avenue;  
Jean Drive – from Towamencin Avenue to Fairgrounds Road;  
Truman Drive;  
Providence Lane;  
Oxford Court;  
Towamencin Avenue – from Providence Lane to Forty Foot Road. “

**SECTION II.** The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Hatfield Township Code.

**SECTION III.** All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

**SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.
