

ORDINANCE NO. 661

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Towamencin, Franconia, Hatfield, Lower Salford, Marlborough, Upper Gwynedd and the Boroughs of Lansdale, North Wales, Souderton and Telford and the Upper Perkiomen Police District, all located in Montgomery County formed the North Penn Area Tactical Response Team (“NPTRT”) and now wishes to merge with Central Montgomery SWAT and dissolve NPTRT as a separate entity pursuant to the terms of the Inter-Governmental Agreement attached hereto (the “Agreement”).

WHEREAS, 54 Pa. C.S. Section 2305 requires a local government to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements by the passage of an Ordinance by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, Hatfield Township desires to execute the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ENACTED and ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, by authority of same that the Township Manager, Aaron Bibro, is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement thereby effectuating the Township’s participation in the same and binding it according to the terms thereof.
