ORDINANCE NO. 635

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HATFIELD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE HATFIELD TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES TO DESIGNATE THE INTERSECTION OF NORMAN AVENUE AND LENHART ROAD AS A 4-WAY STOP INTERSECTION; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has enacted the Hatfield Township Code of Ordinances which contains, *inter alia*, provisions designating certain intersections within Hatfield Township as stop intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Hatfield Township Police Department has conducted a study that determined that there have been numerous accidents at the intersection of Norman Avenue and Lenhart Road; and

WHEREAS, Hatfield Township has conducted the required engineering and traffic study to substantiate the designation of the intersection of Norman Avenue and Lenhart Road as a 4-way stop intersection, a copy of said engineering and traffic study being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interests of the health ,safety and welfare of the residents of Hatfield Township and the traveling public to designate the intersection of Norman Avenue and Lenhart Road as a 4-way stop intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to designate stop intersections on roads within its boundaries by 75 Pa. C.S.A. §6109(6);

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township, and it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by authority of same as follows:

I. The existing stop intersection on Norman Avenue at Lenhart Road in Section 265-22 of the Hatfield Township Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Stop Street	Intersecting of Through Street	Direction of Travel
“Norman Avenue	Lenhart Road	Four-way stop”

II. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

III. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the Hatfield Township Code of Ordinances.

IV. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.
