WHEREAS, Oscar P. Vance Jr. has been the Chief of the Montgomery County Detectives since 1982; and

WHEREAS, prior to his thirty years as Chief, **Oscar P. Vance Jr.** served 18 years in the District Attorney's Office in the capacity of investigator, detective and deputy chief; and

WHEREAS, Oscar P. Vance Jr. served as the first investigator for the Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania in 1972; and

WHEREAS, among many professional affiliations, **Oscar P. Vance Jr.** is the Chairman of Montgomery County Community College Criminal Justice Advisory Board, Executive Director of the International Forensic Hypnosis Association, Chairman of the Executive Board of the Police Chief's Association of Montgomery County and a Board of Trustees Member for Abington Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Oscar P. Vance Jr. honorably served four years in the United States Marine Corps as a military police officer, gunner 81mm mortars and held rank of Sergeant E5 prior to joining Montgomery County District Attorney's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with the foregoing, that the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township does hereby endorse this Resolution as recognition of **Mr. Oscar P. Vance Jr.** for his guidance, leadership, commitment and service to the greater Montgomery County community.
