RESOLUTION #11-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF HATFIELD TOWNSHIP,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PERMITTING THE REPLACEMENT,
CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN SANITARY SEWER
FACILITIES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP'S FLOODPLAIN CONSERVATION
DISTRICT.**

RECITALS:

A. Hatfield Township Municipal Authority ("Authority") is the agency within Hatfield Township, Montgomery County ("Township") responsible for providing sanitary sewer capacity and sanitary sewer service within the Township.

B. The Authority has an existing sanitary sewer interceptor line which was constructed during the 1960s and needs to be replaced.

C. The Authority is in the process of obtaining all necessary easements, rights of way and permits for the construction of a new sanitary sewer interceptor line.

D. The location of portions of the line will be located within the Township's Floodplain Conservation Zoning District.

E. Sanitary sewer improvements are a permitted use within the Floodplain Conservation Zoning District pursuant to Section 282-164(A)(6) of the Township Zoning Ordinance upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and Township Engineer.

F. Pursuant to a review letter dated December 20, 2010, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A", CKS Engineers, Inc., the Township Engineer, approved the Authority's construction of the project in the Floodplain Conservation District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Hatfield Township as follows:

1). Pursuant to Section 282-164(A)(6) of the Hatfield Township Zoning Ordinance, the Board of Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the Authority to replace the existing sanitary sewer interceptor line and to construct and maintain a new sanitary sewer interceptor line within the Township's Floodplain Conservation District.

2). The Authority is solely responsible for obtaining any and all necessary permits and approvals from outside agencies for the replacement and construction of the sanitary sewer interceptor line.

3). All resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety.
