RESOLUTION 13-04

ADOPTING THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, hazards including flooding periodically threaten the safety of people and result in property damage in Hatfield Township; and

WHEREAS, the vulnerability of Hatfield Township to some hazard events may be reduced through various mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster relief and Emergency Assistance Act (Stafford Act), 42 U.S.C. 5165, enacted under paragraph 104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act 2000, provides new approaches to mitigation planning and requires local government to prepare and adopt mitigation plans as a condition for receiving certain federal disaster grants and loans and to amend these plans each five years; and

WHEREAS, a Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared in 2007 and adopted by the county and Hatfield Township; and

WHEREAS, a hazard mitigation plan amendment has been prepared by the Montgomery County Planning Commission and Public Safety Department in accordance with appropriate federal guidelines established in accordance with the Stafford Act; and

WHEREAS, the public and Hatfield Township in the county was given an opportunity to fully participate in the preparation of the Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan Amendment process; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hatfield Township Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the Montgomery County Hazard Mitigation Plan Amendment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Fire Marshal & Emergency Management Coordinator is directed to formally submit the a copy of this resolution to Montgomery County to be transmitted to Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) and Federal Emergency management Agency (FEMA) to enable the plan's final approval.
